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Career Summary (1968-2020)

Personal details: I was born in 1949 in Amman, Jordan. I am married, with one son.

Current position: Professor Emeritus of Social Medicine – Health Planning, Faculty of Medicine, University of Crete, Greece.

Studies: I studied Medicine at King’s College Hospital Medical School, University of London (1968-1973). I obtained a Ph.D. from the Medical School, University of Athens in 1978 (*Thesis title: “Medicine in Greece after its entry into the European Economic Community”*) and the M.Sc. in Community Medicine from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, University of London (1980-1981).

I have the title of Specialist in Internal Medicine in Greece (1979) and I am a Member of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of the United Kingdom (1980).

Awards: I am an Associate of King’s College (1973). I have received the Barry Prize (1969), the Warneford Scholarship (1969-1973) and the Bodossakis Foundation Scholarship (1980-1981). I have received Honorary Awards from the Hellenic Association of General Practice (ELEGEIA, 2002), from the Faculty of Public Health of the Medical University of Sofia (2007), from the Hellenic Union of General Practitioners (2010) and from the Hellenic Association of Nurses (2017).

I served as **Vice-Rector of the University of Crete** from March 2010 to August 2011 (Infrastructures & Student Affairs) and from October 2015 to February 2016 (Academic Affairs & Personnel).

Clinical Positions: From 1973 to 1979, I trained in internal medicine in the UK and Greece. In 1980, I served as Locum Lecturer/ Honorary Senior Registrar in Medicine at King’s College Hospital Medical School, University of London.

Health Care Policy and Planning: In 1979, I joined the Health Planning Group at the Ministry of Social Services and in 1982 I was adviser of the Governor of IKA, the Social Security Organisation of Greece. From 1982-1985 I served on the Executive Committee of the Central Health Council, at the Ministry of Health of Greece, where I participated in the planning, preparation and first implementation of the National Health System, focusing particularly on Primary Health Care (Health Centres and General Practice), Mental Health, medical staffing of hospitals and medical specialities.

Positions at the University of Crete: From 1985-2016 I served as Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor of Social Medicine - Health Planning. I was Head of the Health Planning Unit of the University Hospital of Heraklion in 1988-2016, Head of the Clinic of Preventive Medicine and Nutrition in 2009-2016 and Head of other Clinics and Units of the Department of Social Medicine at various times. I have repeatedly served as Chair of the Department of Social Medicine, both of the Faculty of Medicine and of the University Hospital of Heraklion.

During the first 10 years (1986-1996) of the Faculty, I was Chair of the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee, having responsibility for organising the curriculum, for the study regulations and for drafting a new curriculum which was implemented from 1996-1997 onward. I have served as a Deputy Chair (2007-2009) and Chair (2009-2011) of the Faculty's Committee for Postgraduate Studies.

I have served as member of several committees of the Faculty of Medicine and of the University Hospital, including the Committee for Internal Evaluation of the Faculty, the Scientific Council of the Hospital and the Quality Assurance Committee of the University. In 2007-2010, I served on the University Senate, representing the members of the Faculty of Medicine.

I have been a member of several committees and faculty selection boards of other Universities. In 2011-2013, I was a consultant of the European University of Cyprus for the preparation of the new Medical School and the medical curriculum, and in 2018 I had a similar consultancy with Neapolis University of Pafos, Cyprus.

Undergraduate Teaching: I was course organiser and instructor of courses which, in Greece, were taught only at the University of Crete: "Health and Society" in the first year (previously "Introduction to Social Medicine") and the "Clinical Clerkship in Primary Health Care" in the final year. The Clinical Clerkship was the basis for the development of the Network of Primary Care Centres in Crete. I have been responsible for running other courses taught by the Department of Social Medicine.

Master's Courses: From 2003 to 2016, I was Director of Studies of the (new) Master's Course in Public Health and Health Care Management (MPH). During the same period, I was also a member of the course committees and an instructor at the Master's Course in Bioethics (an inter-departmental course run jointly by the Faculties of Philosophical and Social Sciences, Sociology, Biology and Medicine) and the Master's Course in General Practice. I have supervised more than 130 Master's dissertations.

Doctoral Theses: Twenty one Doctoral Theses have been completed under my supervision, and several more are under preparation, while I have been co-supervisor and examiner for a number of theses, among which a Doctoral Thesis in Linköping University, Sweden (1999) and one in Leiden University, Holland (2014).

Vocational Training: I was responsible for the residency training of 20 trainees in General Practice at the University Hospital of Heraklion (1993-2016) and Co-ordinator of training in General Practice for the Region of Crete (and, from 2002-2016), with 71 trainees in 5 hospitals. As Chair of the Education Committee of the Hellenic Association of General Practitioners, I edited the publication of the Log Book for the training of GPs (2003-2006).

Research and Scientific Collaborations: My main research interests are Health Services Research, Health Needs Assessment, National and International Health Policy, Primary Health Care and Medical Education. My research also includes the epidemiology of cancer in Crete and epidemiological and clinical research in General Practice/ Family Medicine. The total funding that I received as Principal

Investigator (through the Special Research Account of the University of Crete) amounts to about €1,400,000.

Since 2003, I participate in the SHARE project, “*Survey of Health, Ageing and Retirement in Europe*” (www.share-project.org), being a member of European working groups and of the co-ordination team for Greece. SHARE is a multidisciplinary and cross-national panel study of more than 45,000 individuals aged 50 or over from 15 countries. Other major projects of which I was Principal Investigator include the “*Improvement of the management of patients in Health Centres with the use of new technologies*” (INTERREG IIIA “Greece-Cyprus”, 2004-2007), the “*Project for the prevention and early detection of risk factors for cardiovascular disease in women living in Crete*” (2012-2015) and the “*Project for the development of a single area of Primary Health Care in relation to geographical and demographic data of the "Kallikrates" scheme and for integrated care in the Aegean Islands*” (2012-2015).

In 2018 I was a Public Health Expert for the project “*Towards a fairer and more effective measurement of access to healthcare across the EU*”.

Publications: My publications include research papers, reviews, concept papers, descriptive and analytical reports and reports of international organisations. I have published 105 papers in international, peer reviewed scientific journals and 48 in Greek language journals. Of these, 62 are listed in PubMed, 101 in Scopus (1002 citations, *h index*: 15) and 89 are in the ISI Web of Knowledge SM data base (771 citations, *h index*: 14). Google Scholar lists 137 papers (2107 Citations, *h index*: 23) and Research Gate 130 (1533 citations). In addition, 26 full papers have been published in Conference Proceedings and 22 Chapters in books. I have co-edited 7 books and conference proceedings, I have co-authored 14 research reports and more than 13 other publications, reports of meetings and studies.

Conferences: I have organised a number of Conferences and scientific meetings, such as the “*Forum for Education in General Practice*” (2003-2007) and the annual Seminar for Training of Trainers in General Practice (2003-2007). I have served as Chair of the organising committee of four conferences and as a member of the scientific or organisational committee of several conferences. More than 160 announcements and abstracts have been presented in conferences, and I have received more than 300 invitations for conference presentations and speeches, round table discussions and chairing of scientific sessions since 1975.

Other Scientific Activities: I have served as invited expert or consultant for issues of health policy, medical education, etc. at several academic and professional organisations and as member of the Editorial Board of several scientific journals in Greece and abroad and I have reviewed papers for publication, research protocols and applications for grants and scholarships for national and international organisations.

I am a member of several scientific associations, including the Hellenic Society of Social Medicine (Chair since 2006).

International Experience: I have participated, as a member of the Greek delegation, as an invited expert or as a consultant in several meetings, committees and workshops of the World Health Organization (WHO) and of the Commission of the European Union (prev. European Community), in the areas of Health Care Organisation, Health Services Research, Primary Health Care (PHC) and Medical Education. I served as Public Health Adviser of the Regional Office for Europe of the World Health Organization (1994-1999), including one year as head of the PHC Unit in the Regional Office in Copenhagen (1996-1997, with a special leave of absence by the University). In these capacities, I organised several meetings and workshops and 3 collaborating networks for PHC. From 2010 to 2012, I served as the Greek national delegate on the “Committee of the 2nd Programme of Community Action in the Field of Health 2008-2013” of the European Commission.

Committees, Boards and Advisory Bodies in Greece: I have served on several committees, boards and advisory bodies of the Ministry of Health and of the Central Health Council, in the areas of organization of health services, Primary Health Care and Medical Education. In 2000-2004, I was Vice-Chairman of the Board of the Regional Health System of Crete. In 2010-2012, I was a member of the Committee of Medical Education and Training of the Central Health Council and a member of the National Board of Public Health.
