COURSE CONTENT

Evaluation of the main symptoms in particular organs:

EARS:

Otalgia, Otorrhea, Poor Hearing, Vertigo, etc.

NOSE:

Rhinorrhage, Rhinorrhea, nasal obstruction, nasal deformities etc.

PHARYNX:

Difficulty in swallowing, dysphagia, dyspnoea etc.

LARYNX:

Hoarse voice, shortness of breath, cough. etc.

Observation of the basic laboratory tests of Audiology, such as Tonic Acoumetry, Tympanometry, Electronystagmometry etc.
