Dr Diamantis Kofteridis (born 1962) is an Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases specialist, Assistant Professor of Internal Medicine at the University of Crete, Greece. He studied Medicine at the G. d'Annunzio University of Chieti, Italy (graduated in 1988), and holds a Doctoral Degree from the University of Crete, Greece (1998). He is specialized, and board certified, in Internal Medicine (1996) and Infectious Diseases (2010).

Currently as Assistant Professor at the University of Crete, he is an Infectious Diseases Consultant and Attending physician in the Department of Internal Medicine of the University Hospital of Heraklion.

He has served the University of Crete in the past as Lecturer (2006-2011), as Attending and Researcher, caring for patients with HIV Infection (1997-1999) and the National Health Service at the King's Cross hospital, Infection and Immunodeficiency Unit, in Scotland, UK (1999-2000) and as Attending Physician at the University Hospital of Heraklion (2000-2006).

Dr Kofteridis is a researcher and has organized several research projects with the University of Crete. The result of his work is 85 original articles in peer-reviewed medical journals. His publications have attracted ~1600 international citations.

Additionally, he has participated in 144 National and International Congresses with 80 and 82 abstracts respectively. He has given 109 lectures in Congresses, Scientific Institutions and Universities, as invited speaker.

Dr Kofteridis has been on the Editorial Board of 2 Medical Journals, and is Reviewer of 32 others. He is member of 5 Medical Societies. From 2014 he is member of the Executive Committee of ESGAP

His main medical interests include infections in immunocompromized hosts and patients with diabetes mellitus, health-care associated acquired infections, antibiotic policies, studies on the effect of several antimicrobial agents on the level of gastrointestinal colonization by *C. albicans* in human and experimental animals and also research on genetic factors predisposing to infections and their severity. He is also member of the Infection Control Committee of the University Hospital of Heraklion and member of the antimicrobial stewardship team.
